**THE 2009 CENSUS TEST** – In preparation for the 2011 Census, Statistics Canada will be conducting a test in and around Red Deer, Alberta and Montreal, Quebec, beginning in the spring of 2009.

**CENSUS TEST JOBS** – Staff is needed for a variety of supervisory and non-supervisory jobs in the test areas. These temporary full and part-time jobs are ideal for: students, recently retired persons, stay-at-home parents, and those wanting to supplement their income.

◆ **Enumerators:** conduct in-person and telephone interviews. In some areas they also list dwellings and drop off census questionnaires. Enumerator jobs start in late April to mid-May depending on location, and may run until the end of July.

Rate of pay is \$13.76 per hour plus authorized expenses.

◆ **Crew Leaders:** train, lead and supervise a team of Enumerators. They may also be involved in the recruitment of staff. These jobs start in early March to mid-April depending on location, and may run until the end of July.

Rate of pay is \$16.86 per hour plus authorized expenses.

**WHO CAN APPLY?** – Candidates must live within the test area in order to be eligible for jobs with the Census Test. All candidates must:

- be available for evening and weekend work
- have full time access to a home computer with Internet
- be 18 years or older
- be a Canadian citizen or be eligible to work in Canada
- pass a written test, interview, reference check, and Royal Canadian Mounted Police security clearance
